



World Invitational Paratriathlon, Hyde Park - London

15th August 2009

A unique opportunity for Paratriathletes to compete at the 2012 Olympic venue in Hyde Park, watched by thousands of spectators and racing alongside the best triathletes in the world.

British Triathlon is pleased to invite Paratriathletes from the UK and around the world to compete in a Super Sprint Triathlon, the event is fully inclusive allowing Paratriathletes to compete in all ITU classifications.

Once your entry has been accepted you will be issued with detailed information, which include times that you must drop your equipment at the venue, and access arrangements to transition. Due to the complex nature of the days schedule you will need to be in London for the majority of the day, as your chairs and handbikes will need to be collected by the organisers prior to your race.

Entry to this race is free provided you meet the entry criteria.

Accommodation offer

We are delighted to be able to offer all successful entrants complimentary accommodation close to the event venue at Imperial University. Rooms will be offered on a bed and breakfast basis, and if required we can allocate a twin room so you may share with your helper/handler.

To take advantage of this offer you must indicate this on your entry form in the appropriate place. You will only be allocated a room if you request one. Rooms are available for the nights of Friday 14th August and Saturday 15th August free of charge.

Once you have requested accommodation you will be supplied with more information.

Transfers

Transport to the hotel is only offered to international competitors, and must be requested no later than two weeks prior to the event. More details will follow after your entry is accepted.

Requests for entry must be submitted no later than **Wednesday 29th July 2009**. Athletes will be informed via email if their entry is successful. Entries will be closed when the entry limit of 40 Paratriathletes is reached. This event is run under the ITU classification system, more details can be supplied on request

Terms & Conditions

Dextro Energy Triathlon ITU World Championship London - 2009 Paratriathlon Race ("the Event")

Participation in the Event is subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. REQUIREMENTS

1.1 Everyone properly registered and accredited and having an official race number of the Dextro Energy Triathlon ITU World Championship London in 2009 can take part in the Event.

1.2. Participants under the age of 18 will need consent from a parent or guardian. Proof of identity and age may be required. Club or federation membership will be required. Your entry fee covers you for third party liability insurance for this race.

1.3 Every participant shall take part in the race briefing. Please observe the information on special hazardous points on your starting information (you will receive upon accreditation).

2. OBLIGATIONS

2.1 Every participant shall make sure that his/her health is in a condition that allows him/her to take part in the Event, and consult a doctor if necessary. He/she shall have proper equipment and wear a helmet during the entire bike section of the competition. This helmet must be in compliance with the British Triathlon Federation regulations.

2.2 A participant must comply with instructions and directions given by Upsolut Sports UK Ltd of 1st Floor 43 Maiden Lane London WC2E 7LL United Kingdom ("the Organiser"), the officials and race marshals.

2.3 After the race all timing transponders have to be returned to one of the collection points. If participants fail to do so, a fee amounting to £50 (Fifty Pounds Sterling) will be charged by the Organiser. If for some important reason the transponder cannot be returned immediately after the completion of the race, it can be returned by recorded post to the Organiser's address by 30 August 2009, however please note that the above mentioned fee will still be deducted and will not be refunded.

3. CONTRACT

3.1 The British Youth & Junior Triathlon Championships 2009 are subject to selection criteria, all those wishing to enter must have completed at least one draft legal triathlon or duathlon. A proof of this has to be provided on the entry form. The application form that constitutes a binding offer of contract vis-à-vis the Organiser has to be sent by post to: Laura Macey, British Triathlon, PO Box 25, Loughborough.

3.2 Each participant may only enter himself or herself. Double entries will not be accepted i.e. if the same person is entered twice, there is no right of a second starting position, or of return of entry fee.

3.3 The contract shall be considered concluded when a) the applicant accepts the terms and conditions of participation and the regulations by signing the application form; b) the entry fee has been received and processed by the Organiser and c) the participant has received confirmation that they can take part in the Event. In the case of minors the application form must be signed by a parent or guardian who at the same time confirms his/her acceptance of the terms and conditions of participation.

3.4 A right to take part in the Event is not guaranteed, is subject to assessment and cannot be transferred without the written permission of the Organiser.

4. PAYMENT

4.1 Payment is accepted by cheques made payable to "British Triathlon Federation" only.

4.2 If the money cannot be collected due to insufficient funds, cover of account or revocation by the applicant (also at a later date), the applicant cannot participate in the Event and will be charged a withdrawal fee.

5. ACCREDITATION

Upon accreditation (in Hyde Park) each participant will receive his/her starting papers upon the presentation of a) confirmation of registration and b) photo identification (e.g. passport or driving license). If a participant cannot appear personally, he/she has to make sure that the starting papers are collected by a person being in the possession of written authorisation. The starting papers cannot be sent by post.

6. WITHDRAWAL BY PARTICIPANT

A free-of-charge withdrawal will be possible up to two weeks after the completion of registration. After the expiry of the two week post completion period, the entry fee will not be refunded. It will be possible with the written permission of the Organiser, to appoint a race substitute. A written request must be sent to the Organisers address and must be received by 10 July 2009, alternatively a request can be made in person between 14 August 2009 and 15 August 2009 upon registration in Hyde Park. A processing fee of £15.00 (Fifteen Pounds Sterling) will be charged for administrative purposes.

7. CANCELLATION OF EVENT / NO-SHOW

If the Event is cancelled because of circumstances of force majeure, the participant will not be entitled to any refunding of the entry fee and compensation of other losses, such as travelling or accommodation expenses. All claims will be forfeited for no-shows.

8. LIABILITY

8.1 Participation will be at the participant's own risk.

8.2 Other than as stated below, the Organiser shall not be liable for any loss, damage or expense caused by cancellation, curtailment or change of schedule of the Event because of

government action, strike, civil commotion, national disaster or other force majeure event or cause beyond the reasonable control of the Organiser.

8.3 In no case shall any liability (other than for death or personal injury) of the Organiser, its staff, agents or contractors arising from acts or defaults at or near the course or otherwise in respect of the Event include any liability for indirect or consequential loss or damage.

8.4 By receiving the race number every participant will state in a binding manner that there are no health concerns as regards his/her participation in this race.

9. COLLECTION AND USE OF DATA

9.1 Personal data disclosed on the registration form will be either stored in Germany by Eventerprise GmbH on behalf of the Organiser or will be stored by the British Triathlon Federation and will be transferred to the Organiser who will process the personal data only for the purpose of organising the Event.

9.2 An applicant agrees that the data disclosed in the registration form can be collected by Eventerprise GmbH or the British Triathlon Federation and transferred to the Organiser who will process the data in order to assess whether an applicant can participate in the Event and for time keeping, placing and result purposes.

9.3 A participant agrees that his/her personal data can be disclosed to the photographer appointed by the Organiser, for the purpose of sending him/her photographs taken on the course and at the finish line. There shall be no obligation for the participant to buy such photos.

9.4 A participant agrees that his/her personal data can be disclosed to the British Triathlon Federation ("BTF"), in order for the BTF to undertake required participation checks.

9.5 A participant acknowledges that their data will be kept for a reasonable period in accordance with legal requirements and for administration purposes.

9.6 A participant has the right to ask for a copy of the information held about them which is subject to the Data Protection Act 1998 (for which the Organiser will may make a small charge) and to correct any inaccuracies in their information.

9.7 An applicant must inform the Organiser of any change of address, contact telephone number or email address. The Organiser accepts no liability for an applicant's failure to do so. Please note that the preferred method of contact is by email.

10. COMPETITION RULES

The competition rules of the British Triathlon Federation shall be applicable (including sports rules, Organisers rules, anti-doping rules, referee rules) including all legal regulations and procedures as well as disciplinary codes. The participant agrees that he/she has read and understood the rules and accepts these rules as binding. Full details of these rules can be found at:

11. MISCELLANEOUS

11.1 By attending the Event, a participant consents to filming and sound recording of themselves as Event participants. The Organiser and [its licensees] and those authorized by it may use such films and recordings (including any copies) without payment.

11.2 By participating in the Event this does not confer any rights (by implication or otherwise) on the participant to use, alter, copy or otherwise deal with any of the symbols, trade marks, logos and/or intellectual property of the Event.

11.3 The Organiser reserves the right to disqualify a participant at any point on reasonable grounds and may take any appropriate action to enforce this right. By way of example, a participant may be disqualified if he/she has behaved in a manner which, in the reasonable opinion of the Organiser, has, or is likely to affect the safety of other participants; or uses threatening, abusive or insulting words or behaviour or in any way provokes or behaves in a manner which may provoke a breach of the peace; or in the reasonable opinion of the Organiser is acting under the influence of alcohol or drugs or fails, when required to produce proof of identity or age.

11.4 A participant shall not engage in any form of "ambush marketing" (ambush marketing is an activity by a party which utilizes the publicity value of an event without having any official involvement or connection with the event) and shall not breach or infringe the rights of any sponsor or other party commercially associated with the Event, nor conduct unauthorized promotions or other commercial activity.

11.4 If any provision of these terms is declared by any judicial or other competent authority to be void voidable illegal or otherwise unenforceable the provision shall be amended in such a reasonable manner or it may be severed from the terms and in either event the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

12. LAW AND JURISDICTION

These conditions are subject to English Law and Jurisdiction.
