Athlete Eligibility

Athletes must have signed and submitted the Athlete Eligibility Condition Form.

Athletes will gain eligibility by earning one of the following conditions:

- Be among the top five at the X South American Games.
- Be among the top five at the Pan American Olympic Festival.
- Be among the top five at the XXII Central American and Caribbean Games.
- Be among the top five at the 2015 South American Triathlon Championships.
- Be among the top five at the 2015 Central American and Caribbean Triathlon Championships.
- Be among the top 250 in the International Triathlon Union (ITU) Points List as of April 30, 2015.
- Be awarded with an invitation slot by the Pan American Triathlon Confederation.

Qualification SystemSlots per NOC

- This qualification system applies equally and independently for men and women.
- Slots obtained belong to the NOCs.
- Each NOC can earn a maximum of three slots.
- NOCs can select from a list of eligible athletes under this system.
- The same athlete cannot qualify for more than one slot per NOC.

Slot allocation

- 1. Direct slots per competitions
 - Slots 1 and 2

1st and 2nd position in the X South American Games (ODESUR), to be held in Santiago, Chile, from March 7 to 18, 2014.

Slots 3 and 4

1st and 2nd position in the PASO (ODEPA) Pan American Olympic Festival, to be held in Monterrey, Mexico, on September 7, 2014.

Slots 5 and 6

1st and 2nd position in the XXII Central American and Caribbean Games, to be held in Veracruz, Mexico, from November 14 to 30, 2014.

Slot 7

1st position in the 2015 South American Triathlon Championship.

Slot 8

1st position in the 2015 Central American and Caribbean Triathlon Championship.

- Reallocation of slots 1 to 8: In the instance where any of slots 1 to 8 are not awarded, they will
 be reallocated to the NOC of the next best-ranked athlete, according to the ITU Points List. If
 not enough athletes are ranked in the top 250 of the ITU Points List, remaining positions will be
 added to the invitation slots.
- 2. Slots per ITU Points List on April 30, 2015
 - Slots 9 to 28
 - Will be assigned to the NOCs, in the athlete order from the ITU Points List.
 - If not enough athletes are ranked in the top 250 of the ITU Points List, remaining positions will be added to the invitation slots.
- 3. Slots per Host Country (Canada)
 - Slots 29 to 31
 - Will be assigned to the Host Country.
 - If the Host Country earns any slots on any of the previous assignment processes, the same number of slots will be assigned according to the ITU Points List as of April 30, 2015.
- 4. Invitation slots
 - Slots 32 to 35
 - Will be assigned by invitation by the Pan American Triathlon Confederation by May 31, 2015.

Confirmation of Quota Places

The individual numeric registration forms, without specific athletes' names but indicating the number of participants in each event, shall be emailed by the NOC to the Pan American Triathlon Confederation (PATCO), with a copy to TO2015, no later than midnight (Central Time), May 13, 2015.

Reallocation of Unused Quota Places

PATCO will complete the reallocation of any unused slots by May 31, 2015.
