Allocation of Qualification Slots

The qualification slot is allocated to the NPC, not to an individual athlete. In the case of a Bipartite Commission Invitation the slot is allocated to the individual athlete, not to the NPC.

Maximum Quota Allocation per NPC

An NPC may be allocated a maximum of two (2) qualification slots per medal event for a maximum total of sixteen (16) qualification slots. Exceptions may be made via the Bipartite Commission Invitation Allocation method.

Athlete Eligibility

To be eligible for selection by an NPC, athletes must:

- be ranked on the ITU Paralympic Qualification Ranking as of 28 June 2020;
- be internationally classified with either a 'Confirmed' sport class status, or a 'Review' or a 'Fixed Review' date sport class status both with a review date after 31 December 2020.

Maximum Entry per NPC

An NPC can enter a maximum of two (2) eligible athletes per medal event. Exceptions may be made via the Bipartite Commission Invitation Allocation method. Each entry must be made in the medal event for which the qualification slot was obtained.

QUALIFICATION SYSTEM

In accordance with ITU regulations, eligible athletes in certain sport classes have the opportunity to obtain a qualification slot in a medal event for a different (higher) sport class. For this purpose the



ITU establishes designated Paralympic Qualification Rankings. These common rankings will be structured as follows:

- PTWC in both genders: comprising both classes PTWC1 and PTWC2;
- PTVI in both genders: comprising the classes PTVI1, PTVI2 and PTVI3;
- Men's PTS4: also including athletes from classes PTS2 and PTS3;
- Men's PTS5: including only athletes from class PTS5;
- Women's PTS2: including only athletes from class PTS2;
- Women's PTS5: also including athletes from classes PTS3 and PTS4.

The distribution of allocation slots is detailed in the following table:

Qualification slots will be allocated as follows:

TIMELINE

28 June 2019	Start of the period for athletes to attain performances to be recorded on the ITU Male and Female Paralympic Qualification Rankings
1 May 2020	Start of the Bipartite Commission Invitation application process
8 May 2020	Deadline for Tokyo 2020 Organising Committee to receive accreditation application forms submitted by NPCs ("Accreditation Long List")
28 June 2020	End of the period for athletes to attain performances to be recorded on the ITU Paralympic Qualification Rankings
5 July 2020	Deadline for NPCs to submit applications for Bipartite Commission Invitations
13 July 2020	ITU notifies in writing to the NPCs the allocation of qualification slots and Bipartite Invitations
22 July 2020	NPCs confirm in writing to ITU the use of allocated qualification and Bipartite slots
29 July 2020	ITU confirms in writing to the NPCs the reallocation of all unused qualification and Bipartite Commission Invitation slots
3 August 2020	Deadline for Tokyo 2020 Organising Committee to receive sport entry forms submitted by NPCs

CONFIRMATION PROCESS OF ALLOCATED SLOTS

By 22 July 2020 each NPC must confirm to ITU in writing (via email) the number of qualification slots they will use. NPCs that have not replied by this date will have lost their slots and ITU may reallocate them.



By 29 July 2020 ITU will confirm in writing the reallocation of all unused qualification slots.

By 29 July 2020 it is officially declared that the respective NPCs will use the allocated slots for the Tokyo 2020 Paralympic Games. Any NPC that does not use its allocated slots may be subject to sanctions by IPC and ITU.

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUALIFICATION SLOTS

Any qualification slot not used by an NPC will be reallocated to the next highest ranked athlete in the respective medal event (not otherwise qualified) on the Paralympic Qualification Ranking closing 28 June 2020.
