		As discussed on various forums in Abu Dhabi, we are keen to remerge the Age-Group events as well from the Sprint & Relay Championships and the Championship Finals. Our original goal was to implement this for 2025, without discarding the option for 2024.	
		As it goes, it is most likely that the 2024 edition of the Championship Finals will be held as a merged option focusing on a potential single weekend, 4 days of competitions. Besides the Elite, U23 and Junior competitions, our priority is to keep the Standard and Sprint Age-Group Championships together with the Age-Group Mixed Relay Championships. The Super-sprint Age-Group Championships will not happen in 2024 after two years in our competition program. Our long term goal is to keep that event as well in our portfolio, but at the moment to find a more sustainable model with the prioritised competitions are in the focus.	
		Our goal is to finalise and announce the host of the 2024 World Triathlon Championship Finals in May, during the Ibiza Multisport Championships where the Executive Board will have a meeting and discuss this topic.
