3	Open Para race discussion	GD provided the insight on the summary below:	
		Present: Grant, Chris, Martin, Neil, Ian	
		Background : Through discussions at the coaches working group, it was proposed that the possibility of re-introducing an open division for Para Triathlon at the World Triathlon Championships. Open Para Triathlon races took place until 2017 at the World Championships. Due to logistics and opportunities through other international race opportunities for athletes, this race venue was discontinued.	



		Rationale: This is an opportunity to provide more Paratriathletes an opportunity to complete and gain exposure to our sport at an introductory international level and help further develop Para Triathlon. The event could help bring in new flags, As well, newer athletes, NFs and/or coaches can gain knowledge of Para Triathlon in a less rigid format.	
		Format:	
		Sprint Distance – 750m swim, 20km bike, 5km run - the logistics of this distance work best in conjunction with other races taking place - allows for some comparison to Elite Para athletes - provides the opportunity to run the event as first waves leading to age group sprint races as done in years past - suggested 3 waves, WC, Standing, VI - Medals may or may not be awarded, could be finisher medal or medals for 3 waves, WC, Standing, VI. There would not be an interval start for any classes.	
		Recommendation: That World Triathlon have an Open Para Triathlon race at the World Triathlon Championships in 2024.
