

## WORLD TRIATHLON CLEAN SPORT EDUCATION PLAN 2021

### Past and Current Analysis of Clean Sport Education at World Triathlon

Education has always been the cornerstone to World Triathlon's Anti-doping Program. We have a strong Development department which has always included Anti-Doping values based education into their courses for athletes, coaches and technical officials at all levels. These have been included in person classes as well as webinars. These courses have focussed on junior and emerging athletes and coaches.

In addition, World Triathlon has included outreach Anti-Doping educational booths at its World Championships for the past decade. These have usually been manned in conjunction with the host NADO, WADA and/or trained volunteers from other International Federations. With one exception, these booths have been placed in public areas so that they have been accessible to the general public as well as all of the Triathlon stakeholders, including all levels of athletes, athlete support personnel, spectators, technical officials, World Triathlon Executive Board members and members of National Federations. In addition, a specific training session was held with the Juniors and their coaches competing in the World Championships as part of their athlete briefing.

Although this was considered successful in reaching a great number of people at the event, it did not necessarily reach the athletes prior to needing a TUE, or having a test. Therefore, World Triathlon tried to work with as many NADOs as possible to make sure that the appropriate people had this important information prior to actually needing it.

### Education Pool

World Triathlon has identified various levels of its Education Pool as its Registered Testing Pool (RTP) athletes, Testing Pool (TP) athletes, accredited coaches for its World Cup and World Triathlon Championships Series events, Junior athletes competing at the World Championships, along with sanctioned athletes returning to competition.

## Goal #1: RTP Athletes for 2021

- 1) RTP athletes must complete WADA's "ADEL for Registered Testing Pool Athletes" course:
  - Certificate shall be provided to World Triathlon at [antidoping@triathlon.org](mailto:antidoping@triathlon.org);
  - Completion by **June 30, 2021**
  
- 2) In the event the Athletes will attend the World Championships in Edmonton and Bermuda, then they should also attend the Outreach Booth:
  - Sign the Clean Sport Pledge at the Booth
  - Completion by **October 18, 2021**

## Goal #2: Athletes attending the Tokyo Olympic and Paralympic Games for 2021

This is only for the athletes accredited for the Tokyo Olympic and Paralympic Games. They must complete WADA's "ADEL for Tokyo 2020 Olympics" course:

- Certificate shall be provided to World Triathlon at [antidoping@triathlon.org](mailto:antidoping@triathlon.org);
- Completion by **June 30, 2021**

## Goal #3: Testing Pool Athletes for 2021

- a) TP athlete must complete the WADA's "International-Level Athletes Education Program" course:
  - Certificate shall be provided to World Triathlon at [antidoping@triathlon.org](mailto:antidoping@triathlon.org);
  - Completion by **June 30, 2021**
  
- b) In the event the athletes will attend the World Triathlon Championships in Edmonton and Bermuda, then they should also attend the Outreach Booth.

#### Goal #4: Junior Athletes and Coaches for 2021

- a) The Junior athletes who will compete at the World Championships and their Coaches will have to follow an Anti-Doping Education course at the Junior Briefing.
- b) Encourage all Junior athletes and Coaches to attend the outreach booth by bringing an outreach booth to their briefing additionally to the one in the expo area.

#### Goal #5: Sanctioned Athletes Returning to Competition.

To request to the sanctioned athletes returning to competition to complete WADA's "ADEL for Registered Testing Pool Athletes" course:

- Certificate must be provided to World Triathlon at [antidoping@triathlon.org](mailto:antidoping@triathlon.org);
- Completion **prior to return competition**

#### Goal #6: High Performance Coaches

National accredited Elite Coaches who would like to be accredited for the World Triathlon Events (for instance: World Triathlon Championships, World Triathlon Championship Series and World Triathlon Cup) must complete WADA's "High Performance Coaches" Education Program":

- Certificate must be provided to World Triathlon at [antidoping@triathlon.org](mailto:antidoping@triathlon.org);
- Completion by **June 30, 2021**

#### Goal #7: Development Coaches

All Coaches who are going through World Triathlon Coaching Education (Level 1 and Level 2) either in person or online must complete WADA's "High Performance Coaches" Education Program":

- Certificate must be provided to World Triathlon at [antidoping@triathlon.org](mailto:antidoping@triathlon.org);
- Completion prior to the end of their Coaching Course

## Goal # 8: Athletes Attending World Triathlon Development Projects:

All athletes are required to attend an Anti-Doping Education session onsite linked to Development Camps or/and review the “Clean Sport” book and complete some quizzes on the World Triathlon Education Hub online.
