

ITU Mixed Relay Qualification Criteria

- 1.** The General Qualification Rules and Procedures for all ITU and Continental Events are outlined in the ITU website under the following link:

- 2. Triathlon Mixed Relay World Championships and Series:**
 - 2.1.** These criteria affect all Triathlon World Championships and Continental Championships in the Elite, U23, Junior, Youth and any combination of these categories;
 - 2.2.** Start lists will contain a maximum of 18 teams. ITU Technical Delegate may modify the number of teams according to the local conditions;
 - 2.3.** Teams will gain a start position according to the following priorities:
 - a.) World Championships and Mixed Relay Series:**
 - (i)** Host National Federation;
 - (ii)** Top 9 teams of the former edition of the World Championships, excluding the host National Federation;
 - (iii)** Top ranked team of previous Continental Championships entered.
 - b.) Continental Championships:**
 - (i)** Host National Federation;
 - (ii)** Top 12 teams of the former edition of the same event, excluding the host National Federation.
 - 2.4.** National Federation will have a maximum quota of one (1) team;
 - 2.5.** Host National Federation will have a maximum quota of one (1) team;
 - 2.6.** Start list will be created 60 days before the first competition day;
 - 2.7.** Invitation: 55 days before the first competition day ITU Invitation panel will award three (3) invitations for World Championships/Series and five (5) invitations for Continental Championships based on the requests, but not limited to it.
