

## ITU Multisport Qualification Criteria

- 1.** The General Qualification Rules and Procedures for all ITU and Continental Events are outlined in the ITU website under the following link:

- 2. Multisport events (Elite, U23, Junior and Paratriathlon):**
  - 2.1.** These criteria affect all World Championships, Continental Championships and other competitions of any ITU Multisport Event;
  - 2.2.** The size of the different start lists is determined by ITU Competition Rules 10.1;
  - 2.3.** Athletes will gain start position based on the points accumulated in the related Multisport ITU Ranking;
  - 2.4.** National Federation will have a maximum quota of six (6) athletes per gender and paratriathlon Medal Event;
  - 2.5.** Host National Federation will have a maximum quota of six (6) athletes per gender and paratriathlon Medal Event.
  
- 3. Age Group events:**
  - 3.1.** These criteria affect all World Championships, Continental Championships and other ITU event;
  - 3.2.** Athletes will gain a start position based on the internal selection processes established by their National Federations;
  - 3.3.** Start list will be created 60 days before the first competition day;
  - 3.4.** National Federations will have a maximum quota of twenty (20) athletes;
  - 3.5.** Host National Federation will have a maximum quota of twenty-five (25) athletes;
  - 3.6.** ITU Technical Delegate may reduce the National Federation and Host National Federation quota;
  - 3.7.** National Federations (including Host National Federation) may request the extension of quotas to the Technical Delegate.
