The Venue (Dakhla Péninsule)











2.1. Race Venue

The venue (Dakhla péninsule) is located in the city center of Dakhla.

Discover the City of Dakhla Peninsula.

Dakhla is a tourist city located in Morocco, the city is the capital of the region of Dakhla Oued Eddahab Founded in 1973 Dakhla is located in the southwest of the Kingdom of Morocco, a city rich in fisheries. On May 8th, 2010, a 60,000-square-meter Moroccan flag-making event weighed 20 tons, coinciding with the birthday of Prince Moulay Hassan. It was adopted in the Guinness Book of Records. Dakhla is a peninsula that extends inside the sea by a distance of about forty kilometers, which makes it floating in the ocean.

Dakhla is located in the Gulf of the same name, about 650 km south of the city of Laayoune and is bordered by three Atlantic coasts and is one of the rare cities where the sea meets the sand dunes, making it a kiss for tourists, especially the sunny days in addition to the strong winds known by this leading city in the field of water sports.

Is an international airport serving the city of Dakhla is among the largest international airports of the Kingdom of Morocco, the airport is operated by the National Airport Office of the Ministry of Equipment, Transport and Logistics of Morocco. The airport has a new air terminal, which opened on 13 December 2010 with international standards in terms of security and quality, with a capacity of 330 thousand passengers per year, unlike the old terminal, which had 55 thousand passengers per year. The modernization and attention to this airport came in line with the Moroccan government's policy of developing the Saharan regions and encouraging tourism in these regions.

Start procedures: Beach.

The Head Referee with assistance of Technical Officials, who are assigned to the start, will start each race.



750m it is located on 210m to the Venue (Dakhla péninsule).

Number of laps: 1 Swim Exit 210m.

Average Water temperature - 19 °C - 26°C degrees Celsius.

Average AIR temperature - 20°C - 29°C degrees Celsius.













Venue (Dakhla péninsule)

A flow through transition has been developed to keep athletes moving forward. Athletes enter the transition and must deposit swim gear in a bin placed beside the bike racks. Athletes' names and/or numbers are displayed on the top of each bike rack. After the helmet is secures, athletes rack the bike by moving forward into the centre lane and towards the mount line. The Transition zone has traditional bike racks one row.

The Bike course on your left hand.











20km go through in the centre city

Number of laps: 4 Description: Totally flat





One (1) wheel station will be located on the bike course. The wheels have to be provided by the teams











5km in the city centre. Number of laps: 2. Description: Totally flat





Two (2) aid stations will be located on the run course.



A penalty box will be located on the run course, (100m before the finish) and at the end of transition in your left hand.
