#### WORLD TRIATHLON COVID-19 HEALTH SCREENING PROCESS

The event will follow World Triathlon's Health Screening process. In this case, the PCR test conducted at the airport will be considered as the pre-race test.

All individuals (except for the LOC, its volunteers and contractors) applying for an accreditation to World Triathlon events must respect the following conditions:

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#### **DOPING CONTROL**

Doping Control will be performed according to the World Triathlon / WADA rules. Doping Control will be located at the Finish area within the Race Village on VIDA hotel/Marasi Beach, next to the medical and recovery areas.

#### **MEDICAL SERVICES**

There will be First Aid and Emergency Medical Services at the Race Village on competition days, provided by our partners at Royal Bahrain Hospital. There will also COVID-19 isolation area at the Venue for any possible COVID-19 related symptoms.

Medical and Paramedical personnel will be available throughout the competition times. Ambulances will be available to provide emergency transfer to hospital. A medical area will be provided on site at the Finish area.

Medical services at the venue are free of charge. Treatment in clinics and practices is to be paid by the participants.

Athletes / teams should make sure that they have appropriate medical insurance.

#### **BIKE MECHANIC SERVICES**

Our bike partner 'Bike Zone shop' will offer bike mechanic support and will be available in the Race Village during athlete check-in on race day and course familiarization sessions at the athletes' lounge. Bike technical support will also be available outside of competition days according to the below schedule:

#### **ACCREDITATION**

The LOC will provide all athlete, coaches, technical officials, journalists etc. with an official accreditation card according to the World Triathlon Event Operational and Technical Requirements.

Accreditation cards for the athletes and coaches will need to be collected in person on Thursday night at VIDA hotel between 17:00 - 19:00.

Only accredited people will be allowed to access certain venue areas. Accreditation cards are number-coded and provide access to specific areas of the competition areas. All accredited persons are requested to carry their accreditation cards with them at all times and to show them upon request.

If accreditations are not picked up at the time given above, they will be distributed at the race package distribution.

#### **SECURITY**

Marasi Security will be responsible for the venue security and Field of Play Crossings (FOP) inside Marasi beach. Marshals will assist and patrol around the Field of Play on race days and traffic management services will be in place on internal roadways at Marasi for any course use / crossings of these internal roadways.

#### TRAVEL INFORMATION

#### **OFFICIAL HOTELS**

The event has an official hotel (VIDA hotel), located in Diyar Al Muharrag at the race village.

#### AIRPORT TRANSFERS

The LOC will provide free transportation for the elite athletes and their team officials from Bahrain International Airport (BAH) to the official hotel (VIDA hotel) and back to the airport.







#### WEATHER CONDITIONS

The climate in Bahrain during December can be summarized as sunny. Daytime maximum temperatures average around 26°C, whilst at night 19°C (66°F) is normal.

#### **COURSE FAMILIARIZATION**

#### **BIKE**

You will be able to familiarize yourself with the bike course on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> December from 09:00 – 10:00. Athletes should gather at The Athletes Village, Marasi beach car park.

Please note: the official race course is otherwise not open for training before the races. The race courses in general are NOT suitable for training.

#### **SWIM**

You will be able to familiarize yourself with the swim course on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> December from 10:30 – 11:20. Athletes should gather at The Athletes Village, Marasi beach car park.

Please note: it is forbidden to swim outside the test swimming zone at any time due to safety restrictions.

#### **RUN**

You will be able to familiarize yourself with the run course on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> December from 10:00 – 10:30. Athletes should gather at The Athletes Village, Marasi beach car park.

Please note: it is forbidden to run outside the test run zone at any time due to safety restrictions.







#### **COMPETITION INFORMATION**

#### **COMPETITION RULES**

The race will follow the latest published competition rules of the World Triathlon.

#### **GENERAL RULES AT COMPETITION SITE**

THERE ARE THE FOLLOWING SPECIFICATIONS:

#### Wheel station:

- At the team wheel station, the volunteers and TOs present at that location must not have any contact with the team wheels. The team representatives are responsible for disinfecting the wheels prior to depositing them at the wheel station. An athlete in need of a spare wheel will be directed by the TO to the proper wheel which can be picked up by the athlete in both cases, the wheel that is left behind by the athlete will be disinfected by the TO before being deposited at the station.

#### Finish Area

- Timing chip removal must be done by the athlete, who must deposit the timing chip to a specific bin close to the exit of the post-finish area.
- Medallist photo at the post-finish area is allowed.
- All recovery stations will be self-served.
- Food provided will be individually wrapped.
- Massage facilities will be provided.
- Athletes must avoid lying or sitting down on the carpet (without any medical need/problems). A minimum number of volunteers will be available to support the athletes and make sure that the athletes are not congregating at the post finish area.

#### Medal Ceremonies

Medal ceremonies will be performed according to the COVID-19 guidelines for medal ceremonies that can be found on the World Triathlon COVID-19 Guidelines for Event Organizers.







#### **RACE COURSE**



#### Start

The start area is on the Marasi beach.

Athletes will start from the Marasi beach

The TD with the assistance of World Triathlon Technical Officials, who are assigned to the start, will start the Swim Course.

Athletes are required to leave their last-minute gear at the swim start inside a dedicated box and the LOC will carry those bags back to the Athletes' Lounge.

#### **Swim Course**

The swim will take place in front of the VIDA Hotel within Marasi beach, a short walk from the race village.

The swim start will be a beach start.

The course will comprise of 1 lap of 750m in an anti-clockwise direction.







The course will be marked with Yellow and Red buoys. Athletes will pass the buoys on their LEFT side.

The exit will take the athletes up to the race village and transition.

The average water temperature at this time of the year is approximately between 21-24 degrees Celsius.

#### **Bike Course**

The cycle course will comprise of 4 laps of 5km, passing beside the race village.

On exiting the race village, athletes turn right and immediately do a U-turn continues for 400m before turning right, continuing the lap towards the race village

At the end of the lap approaching transition there is a sharp U turn which athletes continue until complete the remaining laps.



#### Wheel Station

There is one-wheel station on the bike course. The team station where you can leave your own wheels. The wheels will be collected from the athletes' lounge and be transferred by the LOC to the team wheel station and be returned back to the recovery area.








#### **Penalty Box**

The penalty box is situated 20 meters before the entrance to the Transition / Finish area.



#### **Run Course**

Anticlockwise course, consisting of 3 laps of 1.66km.

Athletes will exit transition and follow the cycle route for 1.66km, do U Turn and back.

At the end of lap 3 the athletes turn left and then right onto the carpet in the finish chute immediately before transition

#### **Aid Stations**

There are 6 aid stations located on the run course, with Aid markers.

#### PROTESTS AND APPEALS

Standard procedures will be followed according to the World Triathlon Competition Rules.
