4.2/ HOW TO ARRIVE TO MADRID

By PLANE

Madrid-Barajas airport (IATA code: MAD, ICAO code: LEMD), is located in the north-east of Madrid, in the district of Barajas, 12 kilometres from the centre of Madrid.

To get from the airport to the city, there are 3 options:

1. Taxi, with a flat rate to the city centre of €30,00.-
2. Metro, line 8.
3. Train (only from terminal T4).

By TRAIN

Madrid is the main geographical enclave for railway communications in Spain. Thanks to its central location, Madrid is the hub of most of the railway lines that connect the peninsula. The two main stations are [Atocha](#) and [Estación de Madrid - Chamartín - Clara Campoamor](#), as they accommodate Media Distancia, Larga Distancia, Alta Velocidad and Cercanías trains. [Renfe](#) is the main railway operator in Spain, although the railway network has been liberalised in recent years and several private companies [OUIGO](#) and [IRYO](#) also offer journeys.

By BUS

Estación Sur de Madrid (Méndez Alvaro) station is the busiest station in the capital. Its pace is frenetic at almost any time of day. Next to it, Avenida de América station is the first point of reference for many travellers as soon as they set foot in Madrid.

By METRO

The [Metro](#) is the most efficient, fastest and cheapest way to get around Madrid. The city has a very extensive [metropolitan network](#), one of the most complete in Europe, and covers almost all parts of the capital and many of the nearby cities. 4.5/WHERE TO PARK IN MADRID

In Madrid, as in any big city, it is not advisable to get around by car. It is always preferable to use public transport. In any case, there are numerous car parks in the city, both [public](#) (see [map](#)) and private, which charge for the time the vehicle remains parked, as well as many [park-and-ride lots](#) (most of them free) in the vicinity of Metro or Renfe suburban railway stations. On-street parking is limited at certain times in the most central districts of the city by the [Regulated Parking Service](#) (SER). In addition, always bear in mind the [measures established when the anti-pollution protocol](#) is activated and that there are zones set by [Madrid 360](#) that limit access to private vehicles.

4.6/ COVID INFORMATION

The use of face masks is no longer compulsory on public transport. The mandatory use of face masks is maintained in hospitals, health centres and in pharmacies.
