According to the actual regulations, The LOC will provide all the Organizing Committee Members, World Triathlon Technical Officials, Athletes, VIPs, media, technical staff, court personnel, volunteers, etc., with an official Accreditation Card.

Athletes and Coaches will receive the accreditations at the athlete's briefing.

Only accredited people will be allowed to access certain venue areas. Accreditation Cards provide access to specific areas of the competition areas.

All accredited people are always requested to carry their Accreditation Cards and to show them upon request. Accreditation Cards are mandatory to access the venue.

SWIM COURSE

The start will be a deep-water start.

The Swim will take place at Malaga Port / Muelle 1. One lap in a counterclockwise course. The average water temperature at this time of the year is approximately 22 degrees.

The pre-transition zone will be located at the swim exit.



TRANSITION 1

A flow-through transition has been developed to keep athletes moving forward.

Bike racks will be horizontal.

BIKE COURSE







The bike course will comprise a link section and three laps, totally flat except for a small portion of the technical part before coming to finish the lap.

WHEEL STATION

There will be two-wheel stations:


- (1) wheel station (team) will be located at the bike laps start ;
- (1) A neutral wheel station will be at the bike u-turn point.


A Bike Penalty Box will be allocated at the end of the bike laps.

TRANSITION 2

From the dismount line, athletes run in the right corridor, entering TA at the same point as T1 and taking the bikes toward their bike racks. The transition zone 2 is a mirror of transition zone 1.

RUN COURSE





The run course will have four laps, and it will be flat.

The Penalty Box will be allocated at the venue before the end of the lap.

Wheel station for PTWC athletes on the run will (see the map).
