

Entry Fee

20,000JPY per athlete (pay by cash before athlete briefing)

Elite Athletes Lounge

Facilities including athletes' lounge are provided to the athletes at the venue of Osaka Castle Park. Sealed bottles of water and energy bars will be offered to the athletes before and after the race in the athletes' lounge.

Medical Services

First Aid and Emergency Medical Services will be available at the venue from May 27th until May 28th before and during the competition hours.

Medical and paramedical personnel from Osaka Medical Association will be available throughout competition times. Several ambulances will be available to provide emergency transfer to the hospital. A medical tent will be provided on-site at the post-finish area.

Possible medical services at the venue are free of charge. Treatment at clinics and during practice is to be paid by the participants. Athletes/teams should ensure that they have appropriate medical insurance.

Bike Mechanic Service

"SHIMANO" will offer a comprehensive bike mechanic support from May 27th to May 28th and is also available in case of emergency.



A private security company will be responsible for the venue security and community police and Field of Play (FOP) marshals will patrol around the Field of Play. Police and a certified traffic management company will manage the road closures and the traffic around the course.

Accommodation and transportation arrangements

LOC will arrange accommodation and transportation for overseas athletes as follows;

Accommodation

All participants are responsible for their own accommodations, with the exception of free accommodation athletes. Please make your own arrangements.

Athletes and teams who wish to stay accommodation can make arrangements through the official travel agency (JTB oct2023@jtb.com).

LOC will arrange bike transportation between Kansai International Airport and the official hotel for those athletes and teams who have made arrangements with JTB.

Transportation

Free Accommodation

Eligible athletes/official must make arrangements with JTB (oct2023@jtb.com) through the representative of each NF. If the arrangements are not made through JTB, the athletes/official will not be eligible.

Eligibility

Two athletes (one male and one female) and one official from Asia Triathlon member countries.

Invitation details

Osaka LOC will pay for the following expenses for the eligible athletes and coaches.

- Accommodation for 3 days and 2 nights from May 26 (Fri.) to 28 (Sun.) (including bike transportation) Hotel will be Sun White.
- *The third and subsequent nights will be at your own expense.
- Round-trip public transportation between the airport and the hotel (5,000 JPY/person)
- *Any amount exceeding this amount is to be paid by the participant.

Please be sure to observe this rule.



Two-wheel stations will be provided, one will be located near the transition area (Team), and other will be located the north turning point of the toll road (Neutral).



Accreditation

LOC will provide all athletes, coaches, technical officials, medias, etc. with an official accreditation card according to the World Triathlon Event Operational and Technical Requirements.

Accreditation cards/wrist bands for athletes and coaches will be handed out during the official registration on May 27th after the Race Package Distribution at the Venue. Only accredited persons will be allowed to access certain venue areas. Accreditation cards are number-coded and provide access to specific areas of the competition areas. All accredited persons are requested to carry their accreditation cards/wrist bands with them at all times and to show them upon request.


