2. REGISTRATION PROCESS AND ENTRY FEES

2.1 REGISTRATION PROCESS

All registrations (Élite, Junior, Paraduathlon and Age Groups) must be done on the TRI system by National Federations.

AGE GROUPS registration process:

- AG athletes will be registered through their National Federation by a designated AG Team Manager;
- AG athletes need to contact their National Federation for further information;
- In case an athlete is not able to get in touch with his/her National Federation, please contact etccaorle@silcaultralite.it
- Any athlete who is participating in more than 1 event will need to be registered separately in each event by his/her NF;
- NFs are to collect the entry fees from athletes. No athlete can directly pay the LOC;
- The registration will be considered valid only after the confirmation of payment;
- Registration process closes on the 26th of February;

2.1 ENTRY FEES

Entry fees are as follows:

- Junior: 130€ - Élite/U23: 140€ - Paraduathlon: 130€ - Age Group Sprint: 140€ - Age Group Standard: 150€










3. VENUE

The Race Venue will be set up by the PalaExpomar, the Olympic Stadium and the Sports Hall, in Via Aldo Moro 21, 30021 Caorle (Venice).















3.1 COURSE FAMILIARIZATION

Bike familiarization will be organized:

- for Élite/U23 and Junior on Friday, March 17th at 14:30
- for Age Groups and Paraduathlon on Friday, March 17th at 15:00

Meeting point is near Transition Area, Via Aldo Moro 21, Caorle.

Only for Élite and Junior: the bike familiarization will be escorted by the police. Due to open roads during the familiarization, it will not be possible to follow the race course direction.

3.2 ATHLETE'S LOUNGE

Athlete's Lounges will be located by track and field Stadium Giovanni Chiggiato (Piazzale Olimpia) and will work for Élite/U23, Junior and Paraduathlon according to Race Schedule.

Age Group Services will be available by Sports Hall Palamare Valter Vicentini (Dressing Rooms, Bags Deposit, Showers, Toilettes).

Access to Athletes Lounge and AG Services will be through Sports Hall: only accredited people will



have access to the Area (athletes and coaches).











3.3 ATHLETES' RACE PACKAGE

Race Package distribution for Élite, U23, Junior and Paraduathlon will be organized immediately after the Race Briefings (at PalaExpomar, via Aldo Moro 21, Caorle).

Race Package distribution for Age Groups will be organized at PalaExpomar (Via Aldo Moro 21):

- Friday, March 17th, from 10:00 to 19:00 (Sprint and Standard Distance)
- Saturday, March 18th from 10:00 to 12:00 and from 14:00 to 18:00 (Standard Distance)

Age Groups Athletes mist carry on an identification document (passport or ID card) and show it to the LOC Staff in order to collect the race package.

3.4 DOPING CONTROL

Doping Control Office will be located at the Olympic Stadium, Piazzale Olimpia, Caorle.

Doping tests will be conducted according to TRI/WADA rules.

The athletes must carry their identification to the doping control facilities.

3.5 SECURITY

Security Service will be provided during the competition in the Athletes Lounge, Transition Area and FOP.

3.6 LOC OFFICE

LOC Office will be located at PalaExpomar, Via Aldo Moro 21, Caorle.

Opening hours will be communicated as soon as possible.

6.2 MEDICAL SERVICES

First Aid and Emergency Medical Services will be available at the Registration area before and during the training sessions, before, during and after (1h) the race.

There will be First Aid and Emergency Medical Services at the Race Village on competition day. Medical and Paramedical personnel will be available throughout the race. Several ambulances will be available to provide emergency transfers to a nearby hospital.

A medical area will be provided on site at the finish area.

Medical services at the venue are free of charge. Treatment in private hospitals are to be paid by participants. Athletes / teams should have their appropriate medical insurance.

7.1 COMPETITION RULES

The event follows the latest published (link) Competitions Rules of the World Triathlon (TRI).

7.2 ATHLETE'S BRIEFING

All briefings will be held at PalaExpomar, via Aldo Moro 21, Caorle:

- Age Group Team Manager Briefing on Friday, March 17th at 16:00
- Paraduathlon Briefing on Friday, March 17th at 16:00
- Junior Briefing on Friday, March 17th at 16:30
- Élite Briefing on Friday, March 17th at 17:00

An Open Hour for Age Group's Frequently Asked Question could be organised and communicated as soon as possible.

7.3 TIMING CHIPS

On race day Élite, U23, Juniors and Paraduathlon athletes will be given a timing chip to be worn on the athletes' ankle.

Athletes will pick up the timing chips before the competitions, during their check-in procedure. Age Groups will be given a timing chip during the Race Package Distribution.

7.4 RESULTS

Results will be uploaded live at the World Triathlon official website www.triathlon.org. All the Results informations will be distributed to the Team Leaders at the Race Office (PalaExpomar).

7.5 PROTEST & APPEALS

Standard procedures will be followed according to the current World Triathlon Competition Rules.

8. ACCREDITATION

The LOC will provide all the Organising Committee Members, TRI Technical Officials, Athletes, VIPs, media, technical staff, court personnel, volunteers, etc. with an official Accreditation Card.

Accreditations will be distributed at Race Office (PalaExpomar, via Aldo Moro 21) with the following schedule:

- Thursday, March 16th from 15:00 to 18:00
- Friday, March 17th from 10:00 to 19:00
- Saturday, March 18th from 10:00 to 12:00 and from 14:00 to 17.00
- Sunday, March 19th from 08:00 to 10:00

Only accredited people will be allowed to access certain venue areas. Accreditation Cards provide access to specific areas of the competition.

All accredited people are requested to carry their Accreditation Cards with them at all times and to show them upon request. Accreditation Cards are mandatory to enter the venue.

Run 5Km (2 laps x 2.5Km) - Bike 20Km (4 laps x 5Km) - Run 2.5Km (1 lap)




















9.2 AGE GROUP - DRAFT LEGAL SPRINT DISTANCE

Run 5Km (2 laps x 2.5Km) - Bike 20Km (1 lap x 20Km) - Run 2.5Km (1 lap)





























9.3 AGE GROUP - NO DRAFT STANDARD DISTANCE

9.4 COURSES DESCRIPTION

RUN

Completely flat, mainly on asphalt, 100m on the beach (compact and carpeted), in the city center of Caorle.

BIKE

Élite: completely flat, good asphalt, technical sections, and turning.

Paraduathlon and Age Group: completely flat, wide and straight roads, good surface.

Credit and Debit cards are accepted almost everyone, but payments of less than 30€ could be requested by cash.

Sunrise at 06.15. Sunset at 18.15.
