Host City Informations

Tunis, Tunisia

Tunis is the huge capital of Tunisia, a country in North Africa. It is located along Lake Tunis, just back from the Gulf of Tunis, on the Mediterranean Sea. It hosts a century-old medina and the Bardo, an archaeological museum where famous Roman mosaics are exhibited in a 15th century palace complex. The ruins of ancient Carthage, reminiscent of a park, are located in the northern districts of the city.

Lac Tunis, Tunisia

The Lake of Tunis is a natural lagoon situated between the city of Tunis and the Mediterranean Sea. Although the lake is 37 square kilometers, it is very shallow. It was once used as the natural harbor of Tunis. The Romans considered the Tunis-Carthage connection to be vital because it gave them control over the fertile hinterland, so they constructed a dam through the lake.

Today, this dam is used as an expressway for cars and railways, connecting Tunis to the harbor, La Goulette, and the coastal cities of Carthage, Sidi Bou Said, and La Marsa. The island of Chikly, located in the northern part of the lake, used to be a Spanish stronghold and is now a nature reserve. In the 19th century, French colonial forces built a canal to cross the lake.

Over time, the lake bed has continued to rise due to sediment deposition, and efforts have been made to develop its shores for commercial, residential, and touristic purposes. The Lake of Tunis is not only an essential part of Tunisia's history but also an important economic and cultural hub for the country.

Host City Attractions

Tunis, Attractions

Tunis is an easygoing capital city, which makes for a perfect introduction to Tunisia before setting off to explore the country further. The heart of the central city is the medina (old town), where simply strolling the squiggly alleyways is the major tourist attraction.



WANDER AROUND MEDINA

Every respectful Arabic city has a fine medina, and Tunis is no exception. The local medina, part of the UNESCO World Heritage List since 1979, was founded in 698 around the Zitouna Mosque. Over centuries it expanded to a large area in the center of Tunis. Today it is home to around seven hundred monuments, including impressive palaces, mosques, and madrasas.

OLD SOUK

Sure, some places are more touristy than others, but in general, this is a wonderful area to explore, not only to see all the amazing historical sites but also to get a feel of the vibrant atmosphere medinas are known for.

Medina is also the best place for souvenir shopping in Tunis – you will find most shops along Rue Jamaa Ezzitouna, connecting Place de la Victoire with the Zitouna Mosque.



ZITOUNA MOSQUE

This is the largest and oldest mosque in Tunisia, dating back to the late 7th century, and a place of great historical, cultural, and religious importance. Many of the columns and pillars you can see are ancient and originally from nearby Carthage. The only fairly new addition to the structure is the minaret that was built in 1894.



SIDI BOUSAID

A bit further from Carthage, on the same suburban train line, you will find another town worth visiting – Sidi Bou Said. This is one of the most charming places to visit in Tunisia, known for its traditional white-blue houses and winding lanes.

The town is made for wandering around, and with so many picturesque corners is so easy to fall in love with the place. There are also numerous cafes and restaurants where you can sit down and relax.

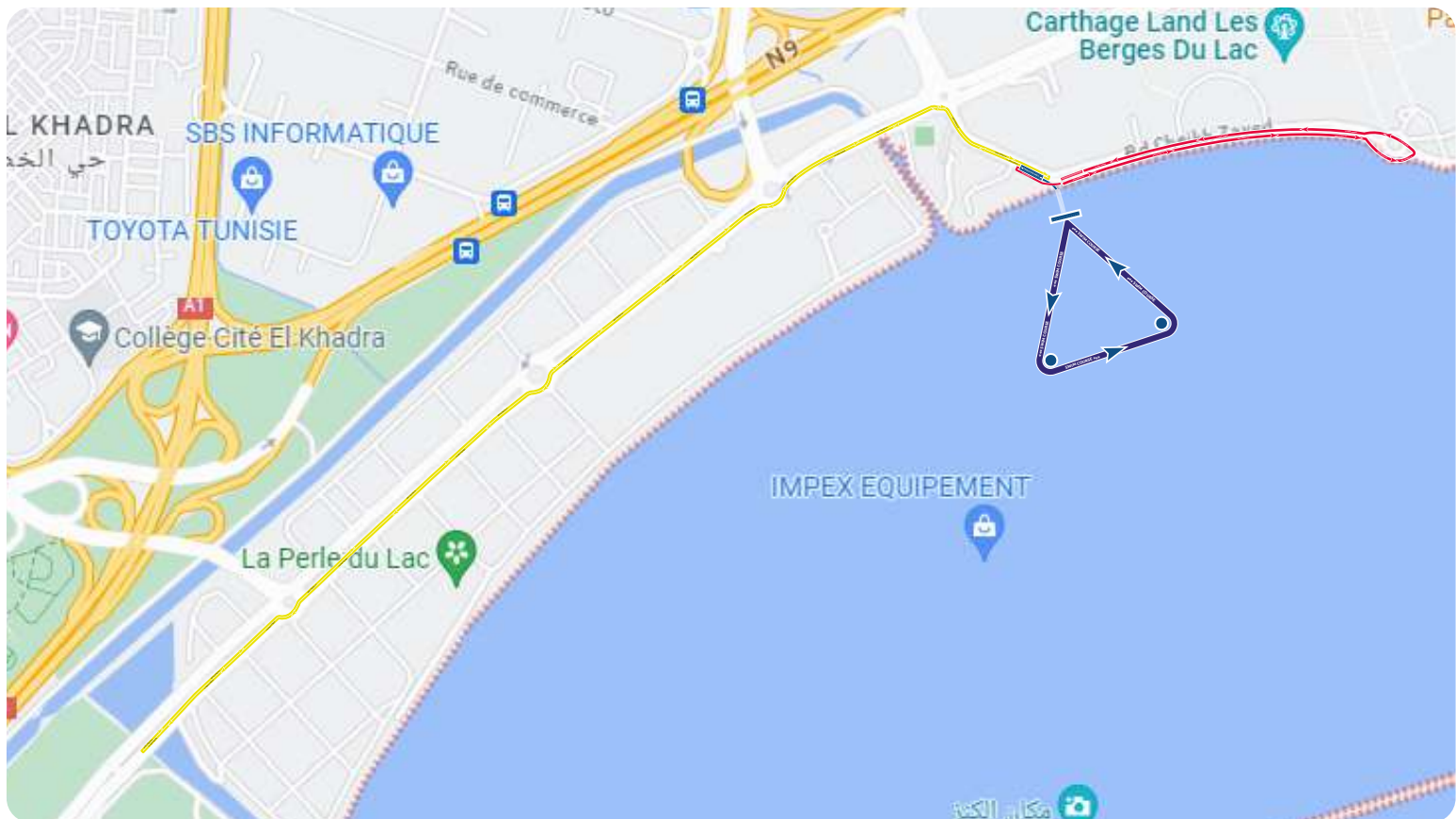


CARTHAGE

In ancient times, Carthage – founded in the 9th century BC – was one of the most important trading centers in the Mediterranean, flourishing for years until it was destroyed in 146 BC after the Punic wars. Today this is a sleepy town just outside of Tunis, where you still can find numerous remnants of the ancient glory. There are so many ruins around, as well as other attractions, that you can easily spend the whole day exploring Carthage.

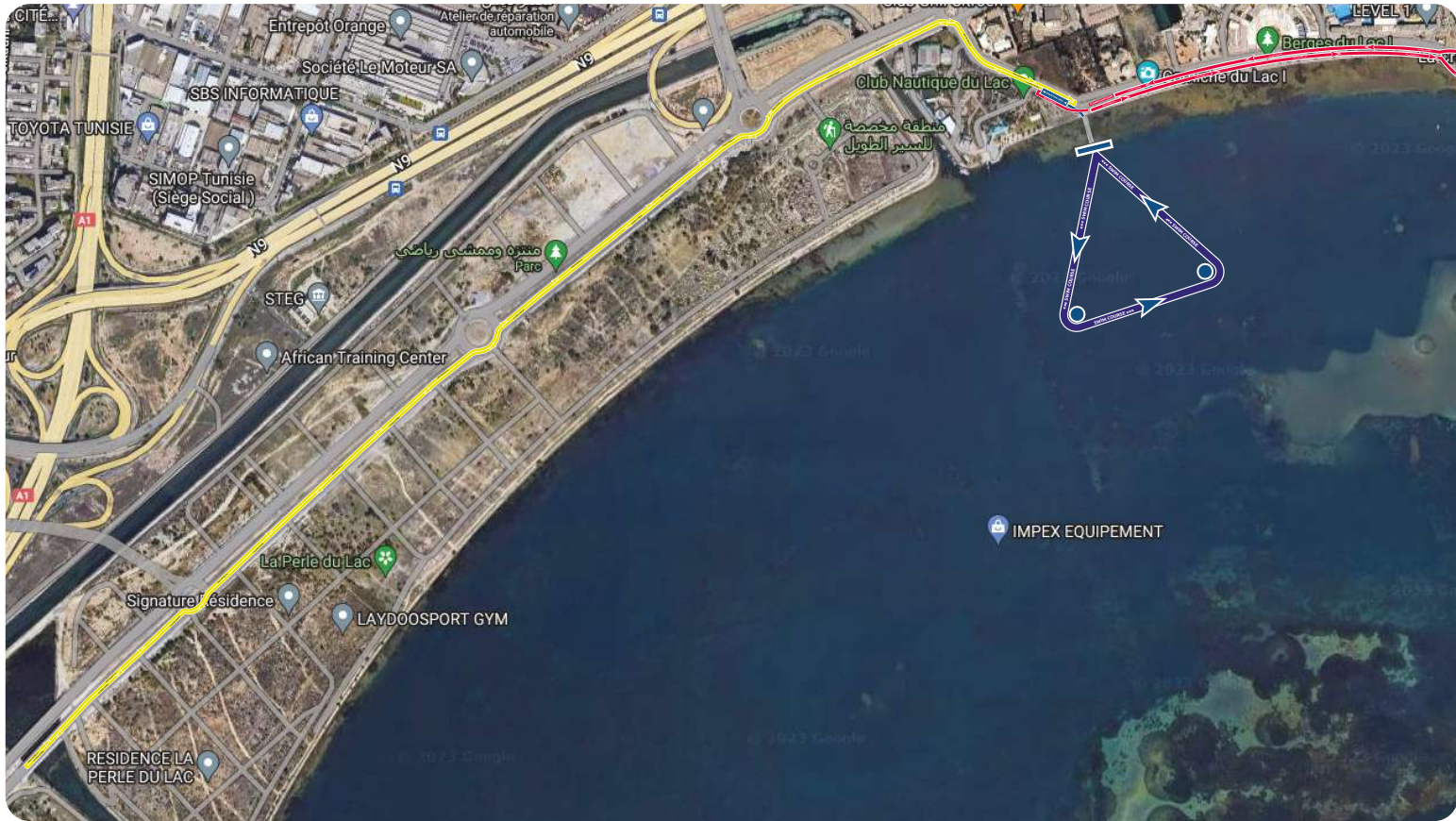

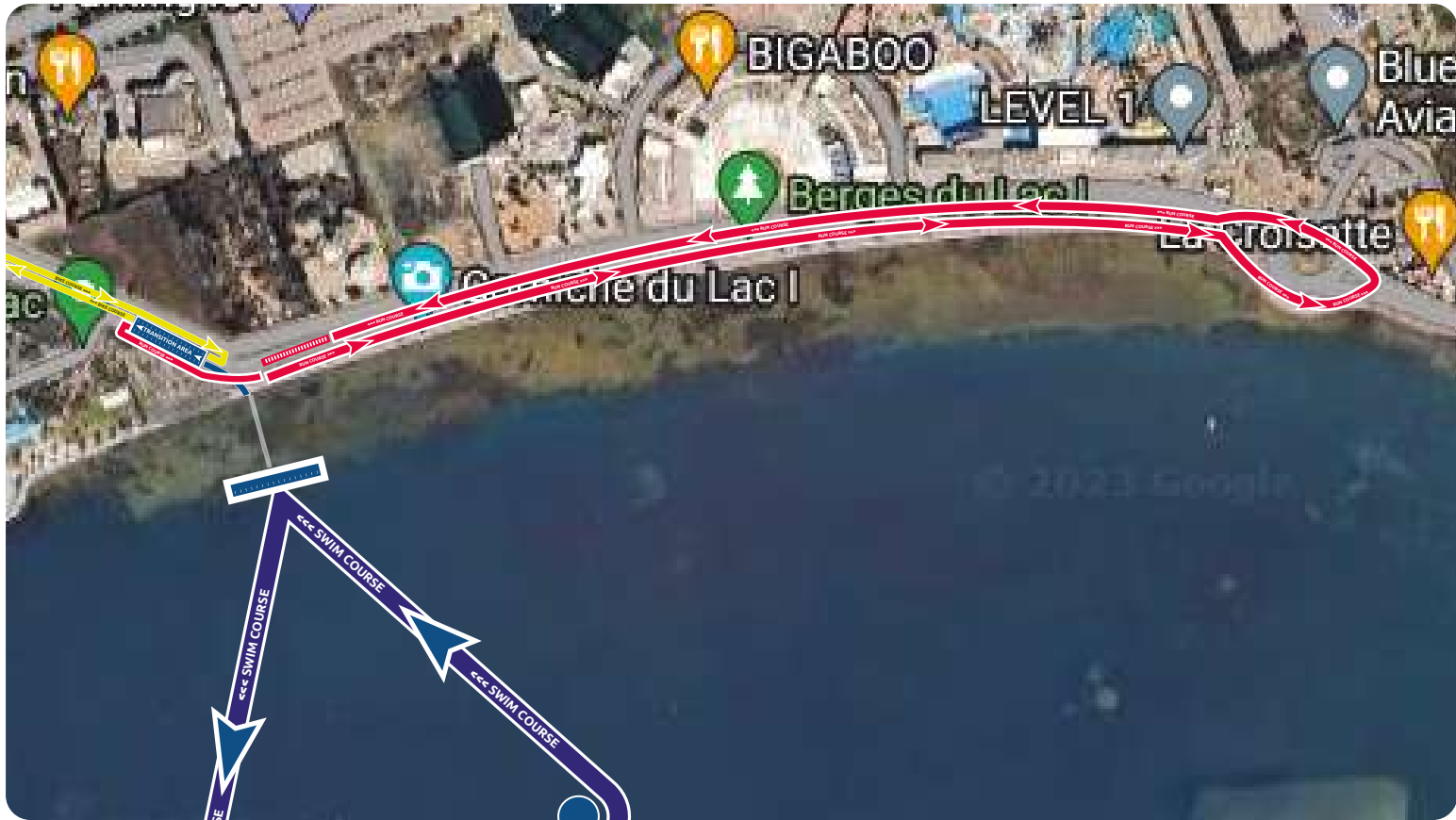

Chekly

Chikli or Chekly is an islet located in the northern part of Lake Tunis, known for housing a Roman and then a Spanish fort. It is connected to the coastal strip by an 8.5 kilometer causeway starting from the lake's spillway, between Le Kram and La Goulette, and oriented east-west.

Athlete's Services

TRAINING FACILITIES

- SWIM- Saturday 04th of November – from 10H00-11H00 with water safety in place
- BIKE - Saturday 04th of November –from 11H30-12H30 - Escorted with road closure. Any other time at your own risk
- RUN
- Running around venue at any time.

MEDICAL SERVICES

- First Aid and Emergency Medical Services will be on-site during the race. The Medical Delegate will be on call at the Host Hotel. Medical personnel will be available throughout the race and ambulances will be available to provide emergency transfers to a nearby hospital. A medical area will be provided on site at the finish area.
- Medical services at the venue are free of charge. Treatments in private hospitals are to be paid by participants. Athletes / teams should make sure that they have appropriate medical insurance.

BIKE MECHANICAL SERVICE

- Bikes will be transported in convoy with the Athlete Bus in secure, closed trucks from the International Airport to the Host hotel.
- Please ensure that your bike has been serviced and in good working order prior to departure from your home country. Bring with you, all specific items required for your bikes should these be unavailable in the city as there is NO BIKE SHOP available in the area.
- A LIMITED selection of spares and equipment will be available from our Bike Mechanical partners who will be on site at the Host hotel to assist with any minor adjustments or repairs that might be necessary after air travel.
- Bikes and bike bags/cases can be stored in the Special Room at the Host hotel free of charge. Please ensure that all bike bags/cases are clearly labelled with your name.

COMPETITION RULES

- The event will follow the latest published Competitions Rules of the World Triathlon.

ATHLETE'S BRIEFING

- The athletes briefing will be live and delivered by the Technical Delegate.
- The briefing will then be available via a link on the World Triathlon and Triathlon website event pages

SWIM CAPS AND TIMING CHIPS

- Just after the briefing the athletes will be given numbered swim cap and a timing chip, to be worn on the athletes'ankle.

RESULTS

- Results will be uploaded on to the World Triathlon official website www.competitions.com. All the Results information will be displayed on the Notice Board at the venue.

PROTEST & APPEALS

- Standard procedures will be followed according to the World Triathlon Competition Rules.



Athlete's Services

ACCREDITATION

- The LOC will provide official Accreditation Cards to all the Organizing Committee Members, World Triathlon Technical Officials, VIPs, Media, technical staff, volunteers, etc.
- Accreditations will be distributed on Saturday 04th of November at the LOC Office
- All those accredited are requested to carry their Accreditation Cards with them at all times, and to show them upon request.
- VIPS: All VIPS, Sponsors and specific sponsor guests will be issued with Accreditation Passes which allows entry into the specified VIP Zone. No entry will be permitted without accreditation.
- COACHES - All coaches must be entered through the World Triathlon System by their National Federation. Accreditation Cards will be issued by the LOC Administration.
- MEDIA - All media personnel will be required to register with the LOC who will issue Accreditation Cards. Press Conferences will be held at specific times, Media Personnel are requested to adhere to the schedule.



Travel and Accommodation
