1. COVID-19 Measures

COVID-19 continues to cause significant challenges which affect the travelling rules, depending on the country of origin or destination and the reasons for travelling. Please read carefully the following information in order to ensure a smooth travel and processes to be completed in order to participate.

Note: the travel information is subject to change depending on the Covid situation. We therefore ask you to regularly check the different websites to stay up-to-date with the information. Following the measures imposed and recommended in Andorra, the following measures will be taken during the celebration of the event:

Access control will be carried out for all those who wish to access the event, which means that they will have to prove that they have a COVID-19 certificate ([EU Digital COVID Certificate | European Commission \(europa.eu\)](#)), which attests to the fulfillment of one of the following conditions:

- a) Be vaccinated against COVID-19 and 14 calendar days have elapsed since the date of administration of the last dose of the complete regimen or have the certificates proving that the person has overcome the disease and is vaccinated against COVID -19 with a dose of the vaccine and it has been 14 days since it has been given.
 - b) Have overcome the disease within less than 6 months.
 - c) Have a test with a negative diagnosis of SARS-CoV-2 (PCR or TMA done within 72 hours prior to the test or a rapid antigen test done within 12 hours prior to the event).
- On the race week, all ELITE/U23, JUNIORS, AND RELATED COACHES/TEAM MEDICAL/SUPPORT NF PERSONNEL, WORLD TRIATHLON STAFF, TECHNICAL OFFICIALS will have to complete an online questionnaire prior to the event via a link provided by the organisation. This does not apply to Age-Group and Para athletes.
 - Elite/U23/Junior athletes, related coaches, TOs in contact with athletes and medical teams shall undergo a pre-event antigen test when they arrive in the host city. See 1.6
 - The use of a mask within the event grounds shall be mandatory for everyone, including athletes, up to 1 minute before the start of the event.
 - It shall be mandatory to respect the safety distances within the event venue.

The organization retains the right to modify the measures required for participation in the event at any time, depending on the evolution of COVID-19, always in collaboration with World Triathlon and the health authorities of the host country.

1.1 Entry to Andorra

As of today, Andorra does not ask for any requirement to enter and/or leave the Andorran territory. **However, the requirements of the border countries Spain and France must be taken into consideration.** Each athlete and staff of the federations must follow the requirements of departure and entry of their country of origin, the border country through which they access Andorran territory and Andorra.

To travel to/through France, all over-12s must show a COVID-19 certificate proving that they are fully vaccinated, or a COVID-19 recovery certificate. If an individual does not have one of these certificates, they must show proof of a negative test result taken within the 24 hours before their arrival. An antigen test can also be taken on arrival.

In Andorra, a COVID-19 certificate* is required in order to enter bars, restaurants and cafés, hotels and tourist accommodation, spas, cultural and sporting venues (including museums, libraries, cinemas and gyms) and beauty salons, casinos and amusement arcades, social care and day centers and cases pairals (activity centers for senior citizens). You will also need to present the certificate in order to attend outdoor events with more than 1,000 people, and indoor events with more than 100 people.

A COVID certificate* must also be presented in all skiing areas in the country, applying to those taking part in a sport, including downhill skiing, snowshoeing and other activities, and to those wishing to use ski lifts, restaurants and enclosed spaces. As for masks, these must be worn at all times, whether indoors or in the waiting areas of lifts. While skiing, it is not compulsory to wear a face covering, but it is highly recommended.

Under 16s are exempt from presenting a COVID certificate* to access establishments, but they must follow all preventive measures, such as wearing a mask.

Given existing healthcare agreements, residents of Spain, France and Portugal are advised to obtain a travel document from the Social Security office of their country. People of other nationalities are advised to take out private travel insurance to provide coverage against COVID-19 or other possible incidents during their stay in Andorra.

1.2 Travel out of Andorra

For all those athletes who need to present a negative test to return to their country, we provide the option to do a TMA or PCR test and antigens test in Andorra. Each athlete must contact their federation to request the test in advance, before the 1st of February, 2022. The event organization will not pay for this test or the expenses related to make it.

1.3 Invitation Letter

All people registered to the event (athletes, National Federation support team, staff, technical officials) who need a mobility justification to reach Andorra may, through their federations, request a letter of invitation to the event by the Andorran Triathlon Federation and signed by its President.

The organization's Athlete Services department will be responsible for managing these permits by certifying that all people applying for permission are registered for the event.

The data necessary to obtain the letter are:

- First and last name
- Date of birth
- Gender
- Number of passport or ID
- Expiry date of passport or ID
- Classification (athlete, coach, etc.) accredited in the World Triathlon online system
- Name and address of your hotel in Andorra
- Arrival date in Andorra
- Departure date of Andorra
- E-mail where to receive the letter

1.4 Pre-event Questionnaire

On the race week **ALL ELITE/U23, JUNIORS, COACHES/TEAM MEDICAL/SUPPORT NF PERSONNEL, WORLD TRIATHLON STAFF, TECHNICAL OFFICIALS** should fill in the pre-event questionnaire.

The link will be sent by the World Triathlon Sport Department one week prior to the event.

The pre-event questionnaire must be filled online in order for the athletes to receive their race packages and the coaches to receive their accreditations. (please note that only one coach and one team medical accreditation by NF will be distributed).

1.5 Antigen test at Race Distribution

On top of the above, **ALL ELITE/U23, JUNIORS, RELATED COACHES, Technical Officials** that will receive accreditation will need to undergo an antigen test at the cost of the organization. If negative, a specific wristband will be distributed and must be worn until Sunday evening.

Please carefully note the times at which this will take place:

- Duathlon World Championships - Wednesday 2 February from 09:15 to 11:00h
- Triathlon World Championships - Friday 4 February from 09:15 to 11:00h

Note: that if participating to both competition, you will not need to repeat the test on Friday.

Also note that time slots per NF will be communicated closer to the event.

In case of positive results, a PCR test will be performed to confirm the positive result. With the positive result of the first antigen test the person will be isolated to a separate area to perform the second test and until knowing the result in order to make a control of a possible positive.

If the result of the second test is negative, the result of the second test will be considered valid.

If the result of this second test is positive, that person will not be allowed to compete in the event.

When a person is positive to the 2nd test, s/he will be separated from the competition and its NF will be informed as well as the local authorities.

The Andorran Ministry of Health will determine the successive actions:

- Return to your home address by the means themselves if the conditions permit.
- Confinement in Andorran territory

If local health authorities require confinement in Andorran territory, as well as extra testing, the organization will facilitate the necessary steps to make this possible BUT **all expenses arising from extra tests and/or accommodation for confinement will be borne by the affected participants and/or federations.**

2.1 How to get to Sant Julià de Lòria, Andorra.

By car

Given Andorra's unique location in the heart of the Pyrenees, all options to cross the border and reach Andorran lands pass by the road. If you prefer to come by car on your own, you should know that, from Spain, you can reach it by the N-145 (south of Andorra) and, from France, by the N-22 (east of the Principality). In our country you will find vehicle rental agencies that will help you organize your trip better.

By train

The train is a good transport option for those coming from distant cities. The nearest train station is in France, in L'Hospitalet-Près-l'Andorre, and is approximately 11 kilometers (7.8 mi) by road

from the border. This station receives trains from other major French cities, especially in the south of the country, such as Toulouse. For those who come from Spain, one interesting solution is Lleida-Pirineus station, where high-speed trains (AVE), mainly Madrid-Puerta de Atocha and Barcelona-Sants arrive. The cities with the closest rail access to the country have a direct bus service to Andorra.

By Plane

The Principality does not have its own airport, but nearby are the most important international airports: Andorra-La Seu Airoport in La Seu d'Urgell (Spain), Blagnac Airport in Toulouse (France), El Prat Airport in Barcelona (Spain), Girona Airport (Spain) and Alguaire Airport in Lleida (Spain). Except in Girona, in these airports there is a daily direct bus service to Andorra and the duration of the journeys ranges from three to four hours.

By bus

Bus connections from the main Catalan stations are mainly concentrated in Barcelona, Tarragona and Lleida. In the case of France, Toulouse bus station has regular service to Andorra.

2.2 Facilities

2.3 Doping control

Doping control will be carried out in accordance with the giving of World Triathlon/World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) and those in charge of the entire process will be the Andorran Doping Agency.

Anti-Doping Policy

Anti-Doping Rules, like Competition rules, are sport rules governing the conditions under which sport is played. Athletes and other persons involved in the event accept these rules as a precondition to compete. All athletes shall be subject to Competition Testing by the World Triathlon, the Athlete's National Federation, Anti-Doping Organizations or any other organization promoting Events in triathlon.

****All athletes must ensure they carry their official identification (Photo ID)****

If you are selected for Doping Control, someone will approach you to notify you. You may be asked to go for Doping Control even before the race, for example, after picking up your registration pack or when you check in your bicycle in the Transition Area. The Doping Control Chaperone and/or Officer will explain the procedure to you but you need to be aware that you have certain rights and responsibilities.

You have the right to:

- A. Appoint a representative of your choice to accompany you to Doping Control.
- B. Request the services of an interpreter in case you do not have a good command of English (if required).
- C. Request additional information about the Doping Control procedure.
- D. Request a delay in reporting to the Doping Control Station for valid reasons. (These reasons may be to receive necessary medical care, locate a representative or fulfil a media commitment but you must have the consent of, and be in full view of, the Doping Control Officer or Chaperone.)
- E. request necessary modifications if you have a disability.
- F. Note any concerns with the Doping Control process on the Doping Control Form.
- G. Request part "B" of your sample be analysed to confirm a positive result.
- H. A fair hearing in compliance with the World Anti-Doping Code.

Your responsibilities include:

- A. Be aware of, and comply with, the World Anti-Doping Code and the World Triathlon Anti-Doping Rules.
- B. Be aware of which substances are not allowed and are included in the Prohibited List.
- C. Comply with requirements for Therapeutic Use Exemptions (TUE). A TUE allows you to take a substance included in the Prohibited List, if that is the only option available to you and you meet specific requirements. There are strict rules governing TUEs so it is best to check them before the event. As an Age-Group athlete you may apply for a retroactive TUE but it is not guaranteed, so you may want to request one no later than 30 days prior to racing.
- D. Report to the Doping Control Station immediately or within the required time slot specified by the Doping Control Chaperone.
- E. Control your sample until it is sealed in the sample collection kit.
- F. Ensure the sealed sample collection kit is secure and identified.
- G. Ensure all documentation is accurate.

You must carry with you an ID/passport with photo when proceeding to the Doping Control Station. It is also a good idea to make sure that you have access to your National Federation manager's phone number so that you can let him/her know that you have been selected for Doping Control.

2.4 Medical service

2.4.1 Medications

If you are taking prescription drugs that are included in the World Anti-Doping Agency (AMA) Prohibitions List, make sure you have received a Therapeutic Use Authorization from your National Anti-Doping Agency and bring a copy.

2.5 Insurance

The competition has a policy of insurance of civil liability and material damages that occur within the framework of the organization of the event.

All athletes competing in a World Triathlon event must have personal insurance guaranteed by their National Federation. This insurance will cover:

- 1- Any accident occurred before, during and after any competition.
- 2- Any illness that an athlete may suffer during the trip to a competition or event.
- 3- The athlete's responsibility during the competition.

With their registration for the event, the National Federations guarantee insurance coverage for all athletes.

2.6 Mechanical service and ski assistance

For a suitable service, the rental of mountain biking and cross-country skiing booking must be done in advance, not during the days of the event.


5.13 Timing Chips

As for the Categories Elite, U23, Junior and Paratriathlon will receive a timing chip at the same time that they receive the competition bib in the Athletes' lounge.

The Age Groups athletes will receive the timing chip before the check-in into transition. When competing they will have to wear it on the left ankle. Once the competition is over the athletes will have to return the chip to leave the Finish Area. The athlete will be charged EUR50 for the loss of the timing chip.

5.14 Bag-drop

Before the competition, athletes can go to the athlete lounge to leave their bags and pick them back after the competition.
