Information regarding the application of the uniform rules at the 2024 World Triathlon Winter Championships Pragelato-Sestriere

The 2024 World Triathlon Winter Championships Pragelato-Sestriere are upon us, and we have had several inquiries about the uniform rules applicable at said event. Therefore we want to clarify the necessary minimum standards to be applied in the different categories ahead of time to allow for planning.

Elite/U23/Junior/Para

For athletes in the Elite/U23/Junior/Para category the following rules apply:

Only uniforms that have been approved by World Triathlon and published in the uniform catalogue for Multisports (<https://drive.google.com/file/d/1U16B0Cc7rJCzW8pc8iLHDDyUZqtRPmAv/view>) can be worn by athletes in those categories.

If a National Federation has entered a Winter Triathlon suit into the catalogue, this is the preferable option.

If a National Federation has not entered a Winter Triathlon suit, or an athlete cannot acquire one, the 'summer' suit (tri suit) can be worn on top. The clothing underneath must be the colour of the national uniform or plain black/dark blue. No sponsor logos are allowed to be visible on the underlayer clothing, or need to be covered.

Age Group

For athletes competing in the Age Group categories, the following rules apply:

Uniforms that have been entered by the National Federation into the World Triathlon uniform catalogue for Age Group

(https://drive.google.com/file/d/1UXI65tk_4yDk65PLJ4TqAJa5Fa3n-4Fd/view) are to be worn. If an athlete wears a 'summer' uniform (tri suit) on top, the clothing underneath must be the colour of the national uniform or plain black/dark blue. No sponsor logos are allowed to be visible on the underlayer clothing, or need to be covered.

If the athlete cannot acquire a suit as defined above, the following rules apply:

- The athlete has to ask for permission from the National Federation to start without the approved NF suit.
- If permission is granted the athlete can wear clothing in the colour of the national uniform or plain black/dark blue. No sponsor logos are allowed to be visible during the race on the underlayer clothing, or need to be covered.

In general we will try to give access to as many athletes as possible to these events and therefore don't want to exclude anyone on the fact of the uniform alone, while still maintaining the principles set in the Competition Rules for a World Championship event.
