
### Introduction

### Korea

South Korea is officially the republic of Korea. *Daehan Minguk (*lit. "The Great Country of the *Han* People"), is a country in East Asia, constituting the southern part of the Korean Peninsula and lying east to the Asian mainland.

The name *Korea* is derived from Goryeo, a dynasty which ruled from the 10th to 14th centuries. South Korea lies in the north temperate zone and has a predominantly mountainous terrain.

It comprises an estimated 51.4 million residents distributed over 99,392km<sup>2</sup> (38,375 sq mi). The capital and largest city is Seoul, with a population of 10 million.





### Introduction

### Gyeongju

Gyeongju was the capital of the ancient kingdom of Silla (57 BC - 935 AD), which ruled about two-thirds of the Korean Peninsula at its height between the 7th and 9th centuries, for close to one thousand years. Later Silla was a prosperous and wealthy country, and its metropolitan capital of Gyeongju was the fourth largest city in the world. A vast number of archaeological sites and cultural properties from this period remain in the city. Gyeongju is often referred to as "the museum without walls". Among such historical treasures, Seokguram grotto, Bulguksa temple, Gyeongju Historic Areas and Yangdong Folk Village are designated as World Heritage Sites by UNESCO. The many major historical sites have helped Gyeongju become one of the most popular tourist destinations in South Korea.

Transportation

Busan International Airport (Closest airport )

Air

The closest airport is Busan International Airport. There are many direct flights from major Asia cities such as Beijing, Tokyo, Osaka, Hong Kong, Macau, Taipei, Bangkok, Kuala Lumpur, and so on.

Also there are many domestic flights from Incheon international airport to Busan

LOC will provide airport pick up and drop off service for all participants from Busan International Airport.

It takes 1 hour 20 minutes (90.4km) from Busan International Airport to the host hotel by car.





### ACCOMODATION

LOC Provide 4 nights & 5 days accommodation inclusive of breakfast for 8 athletes and 2 officials from each ASTC member country. (2 quadruple rooms and 1 twin room)



#### SWIM COURSE

#### Elite, U23, Junior, U15, Para

There is two lap to swim for Elite and U23. Other categories are one lap course. The first turn is after 330m. You will exit the ramp of the start pontoon.

The water temperature in the middle of June can be expected to be approximately  $20.1^{\circ}$ C to  $23^{\circ}$ C. Wetsuit will not be used.

#### **BIKE COURSE**

#### Elite, U23, Junior, U15, Para

There are 6 laps of 6.6km to ride for Elite and U23. 3laps of 6.6km for Junior and Para. 2 laps of 5km for U15. A bit hilly with some technical corners and 2 u-turns. 2 wheels stops per lap

### WHEEL STATIONS / PENALTY BOX

#### Elite

There are two Wheel Stations in the bike course.

Wheel station 1: next to Transition, athletes/teams need to bring their own wheels .

Wheel station 2: Located at bike turning point provided by the LOC. Neutral wheel is Shimano 11 gears

#### **RUN COURSE**

#### Elite, U23, Junior, U15, Para

A bit hilly course. There are 4 laps of 2.5km to run for Elite and U23. 2 laps of 2.5km for Junior and Para. 1 lap of 2.5km for U15

AID STATIONS

#### Elite, U23, Junior, U15, Para

The aid station are located on the run course at 800m intervals. Closed 0.5 liter bottles of sealed water will be handed out.

### WEATHER CONDITIONS

The air temperature in  $\,$  race weekend is from 20  $^{\circ}\mathrm{C}$  to 33  $^{\circ}\mathrm{C}$

Results will be uploaded live at ITU's official website: <u>www.triathlon.org</u> All the results information will be distributed to the Team Leaders at the LOC information Office.



### **PROTEST & APPEALS**

Standard procedures will be followed according to the ITU Competition Rules.

### ACCREDITAION

LOC will provide all athletes, coaches, technical officials, medias, etc. with an official accreditation card according to the ITU Event Operational and Technical Requirements.

Wrest band for athletes and accreditation cards for coaches will be handed out during the official registration on June 19th after the Race Briefing .

Only accredited persons will be allowed to access certain venue areas. Accreditation cards are number-coded and provide access to specific areas of the competition areas. All accredited persons are requested to carry their accreditation cards with them at all times and to show them upon request.

National Federation representatives and observers apply for accreditation by sending their request to the ITU.


