PRE-RACE LOGISTICS

MANDATORY MEETING

All athletes must attend a mandatory meeting on **Friday, March 6, 2015 at 5:00 pm** at the **Clermont Arts and Recreation Center** (3700 South Highway 27, Clermont, FL 34711). This is a NEW location for us, please make note. You must attend this meeting in order to race.

Before you are allowed in the mandatory meeting room you need to check with race officials that you have registered for the race and you have paid for the race registration fee. You **MUST** bring a valid photo ID or passport to the mandatory meeting.

IMPORTANT: If you have NOT paid the race registration fee yet, we highly encourage you to register online now at www.draftlegalchallenge.com. This will save you time and money. We will charge \$10 more if you are paying the registration fee onsite at the pre-race meeting (\$95 total). Register now or be prepared to bring \$95 - cash or a credit card to the pre-race meeting.

RACE NUMBERS

The following items will help identify you during the race:

- Number Tattoos – you will be given four tattoos (one for each arm, one for the front of each thigh) that you will need to apply **BEFORE** you come to the race venue.
- Bike Frame Number – must be attached so the number is visible from both sides of your bike.
- Helmet Number – must be attached to the front of the your bike helmet.
- The Timing Chip – must be worn on one of your ankles during the entire event. You will pick up the timing chip on the beach at the swim start.

RACE DAY TIMELINE AND PARKING

Please see the Race Day Timeline on our website www.draftlegalchallenge.com which details the race timeline and parking instructions. It is very important that all athletes follow the timeline.

ELITE WOMEN – Your race starts at **10:00 AM**. You MUST be in Lake Louisa State Park (7305 U.S. Highway 27, Clermont, FL) before your assigned 10 minute parking queue of **8:20 – 8:30 AM**. This is imperative. The event parking lot is WITHIN the closed bike course. At 8:20 – 8:30 AM your car will be escorted to the event parking lot. Plan to arrive before the 10 minute window. If you miss this window you will not be able to race.

ELITE MEN – Your race starts at **11:30 AM**. You MUST be in Lake Louisa State Park (7305 U.S. Highway 27, Clermont, FL) before your assigned 10 minute parking queue of **9:50 – 10:00 AM**. This is imperative. The event parking lot is WITHIN the closed bike course. At 9:50 – 10:00 AM your car will be escorted to the event parking lot. Plan to arrive before the 10 minute window. If you miss this window you will not be able to race. Note: you can also arrive at the 8:20 – 8:30 AM parking queue if you would like to arrive earlier to the race venue.

*The **parking fee to enter the park is \$5 per car** (cash only).

*No parking is allowed anywhere else in the park including along Park Drive (within the park). All athletes and spectators **MUST** use the main event parking lot.

You are welcome to come to the venue on Friday (the day before the race) to see the venue and warm up on the course. The course will not be marked and set up until Friday mid-afternoon. Note: you will be required to pay the \$5 per car fee to enter the park. Also, there are no lifeguards on duty. You are swimming and riding on the course at your own risk.

AWARD CEREMONY – Will take place for the Elite Women and Men at approximately 12:50 PM.



COURSE INFORMATION

750 meter swim / 20k bike (FOUR LOOPS) / 5k run (TWO LOOPS)

The race venue located inside of the Lake Louisa State Park offers an ideal place for a triathlon. Just a short drive from Orlando, Lake Louisa State Park is noted for its six beautiful lakes, rolling hills, and scenic landscapes. Lake Louisa is the largest in a chain of 13 lakes connected by the Palatka River, which is designated as an Outstanding Florida Waterway.

The entire race course is closed to traffic. The 750 meter swim takes place from a beach start in a clear lake with average temperature ranging in the high 60's F. Wetsuits will NOT be allowed for temperatures 68 degrees or higher. Following the swim, the race will take athletes on a **FOUR** loop bike course on a well paved and fast road. After completing the 20k bike course, athletes will complete **TWO** loops of the run course.

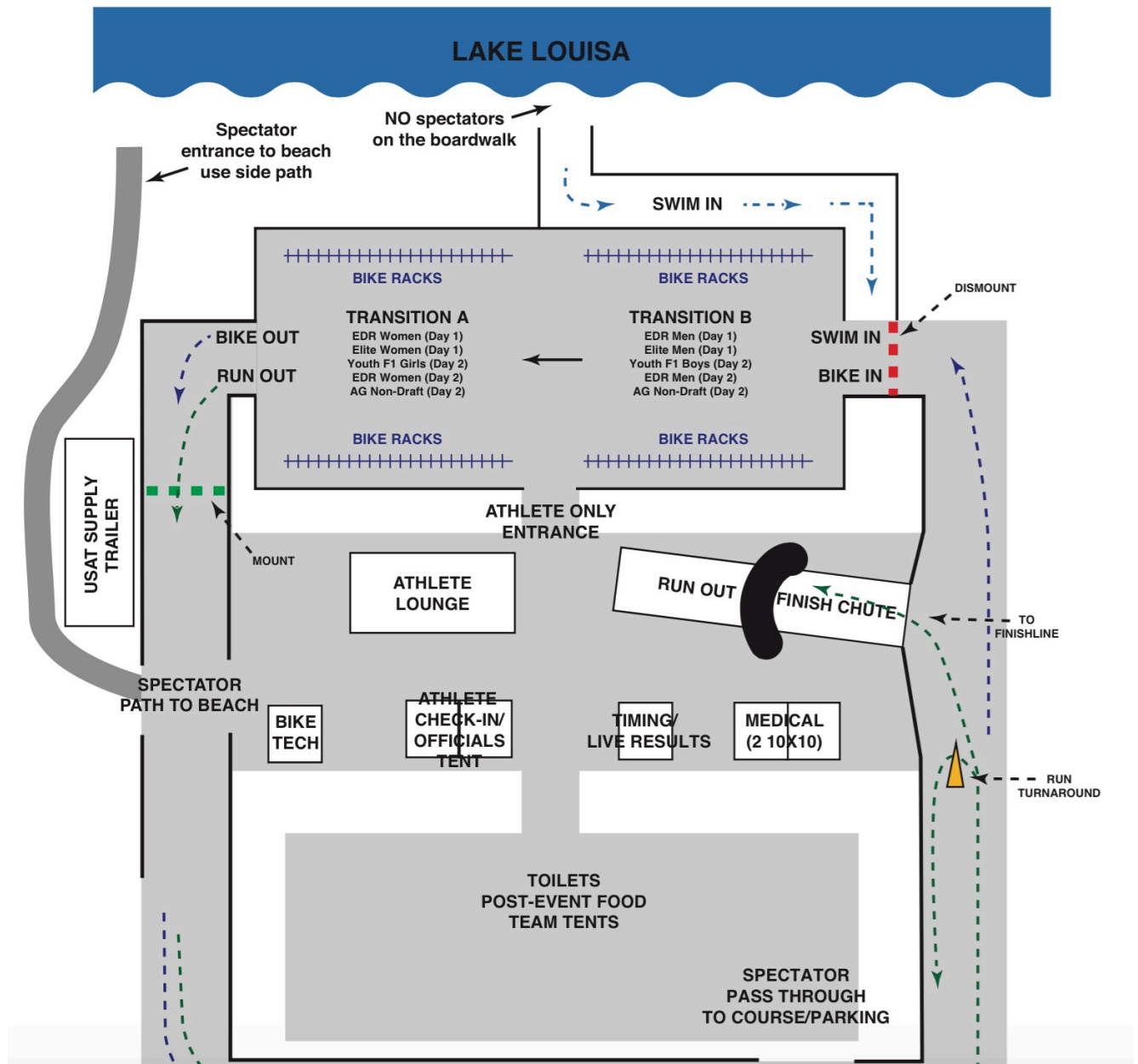

OTHER INFORMATION

Pre-Race Course Review – You are welcome to come to Lake Louisa Park to check out the venue. The course will not be marked and set up until Friday afternoon, March 6th. You will need to pay a \$5 per car (cash) entrance fee to enter the park.

Remember to Bring your ID – Remember to bring your ID to the mandatory meeting. No ID = no race packet. No exceptions.

Post Race Food. Athletes will have access to free food and beverage following the race.

Easy Exit Access. You will be able to leave the park anytime using the back entrance of the park.

Spectators. Make sure you tell your family and friends they MUST be in the park and parked during the assigned parking 10 minute parking queues. This will be enforced!
