Dear President,

Swiss Triathlon will comply with all requirements of the World Triathlon Constitution including but not limited to the following items:

- 1. Refer to the Court of Arbitration for Sport (Lausanne) any disputes which may arise between Swiss triathlon and World Triathlon; including, but not limited to Anti-Doping.
- 2. Comply with all other matters as outlined in the World Triathlon Constitution, including (but not limited to) the World Anti-Doping Code (WAD Code) and all the International Standards and adopt the World Triathlon Anti-Doping Rules.
- 3. Ensure gender equality on all elected committees and as a policy relating to all practices.

Given what has been requested, we wish to specify and define that:

- 1. We ask that a certain time frame be granted to update the statutes to what World Triathlon requires. Normally, and as a minimum, one year is granted.
- In Switzerland we find it difficult to make the required changes in such a short time, and certain changes in the statutes are in slight conflict with what we are asked to do by Swiss Olympic respectively BASPO (Federal Office of Sport), which finances a large part of our activities.
- 3. In this sense, we ask that what is requested be evaluated on a case by case basis and that this does not automatically lead to critical situations between the national federation and the international federation.
